School Gates

In the interests of safeguarding all children we will be implementing some new times for access to the school building and grounds from the 2nd October.

The school gates will be opened in the mornings no earlier than 8.40am. Nobody will be allowed onto the playground or into the Muggleton Centre before 8.40am unless they are booked into Breakfast Club, a before school sports club, have a prior appointment booked or need to speak to the reception staff. Supervision is provided on the playground from 8.45am and school starts at 8.55am.

At the end of the day the school gates at FS2 and KS1 will be opened at 3.05pm and at KS2 at 3.10pm. No persons collecting children should be on the playground or in the Muggleton Centre before then. Please only use the gates to access or leave the school site.
