

Early Years Foundation Stage: 70% of children achieved a good level of development (National: 72%)

Key Stage 1 Outcomes 2017/18

Children reaching the expected standard or higher in Reading, Writing and Maths

Reading: 84% (National: 75%) including 27% (National: 26%) achieving greater depth.

Writing: 81% (National: 70%), including 18% (National: 16%) of children achieving greater depth.

Maths: 82% (National: 76%) including 25% (National: 22%) of children achieving greater depth.

Key Stage 2 Outcomes 2017/18

Children reaching the expected standard or higher in Reading, Writing and Maths

Reading: 72% (National: 75%) including 16% (National: 28%) achieving a higher standard.

Writing: 82% (National: 78%) including 20% (National: 20%) of children achieving a higher standard.

Maths: 60% (National: 76%) including 9% (National: 24%) of children achieving a higher standard.

Reading, Writing and Maths Combined

54% (National: 64%) of children achieved the expected standard and 5% (National: 10%) of children achieved the higher standard.

English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

73% (National: 78%) of children achieved the expected standard and 23% (National: 34%) of children achieved the higher standard.

Average progress in Reading, Writing and Maths

Reading: - 3.08 (National: 0.03)

Writing: - 0.45 (National: 0.03)

Maths: - 4.74 (National: 0.03)

Interpreting Progress Scores

Progress scores are positive and negative numbers either side of zero.

- A score of 0 means children in this school, on average, do about as well at Key Stage 2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A positive score means children in this school on average made more progress from KS1 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A negative score means children in this school on average made less progress from KS1 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.
