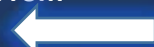


Subject Specific Vocabulary

Capsize	When a boat or ship turns over in the water.
Charity	A group that raises money for people or animals in need.
Coastline	The place where the land meets the sea or ocean.
Compass	An instrument used for showing the direction.
Emergency	A situation that is serious and dangerous and needs urgent help.
Explorer	A person who travels to places to learn about them.
Feature	Something that is part of an area of land.
Volunteer	A person who works without being paid.

What are the four countries that make up the UK?

The UK is a union of four countries and is surrounded by four seas and oceans.

How are physical features formed and how can they be changed?

Physical features are naturally formed. Humans haven't made them. Rain, wind and the sea can change physical features over time.

What is an example of a human feature?

Human features are those that have been made by humans such as shops, roads and piers.

How are features marked onto a map?

Maps are used to help people find their way from one place to another. Physical and human features are marked on a map with symbols.

What is the process of erosion and how does it happen?

Erosion is a natural process where materials are moved from one place to another. Over time the coastline is worn away by waves.

How can I stay safe at the coastline?

The coastline can be a dangerous place. It is important to stay safe and know what to do in an emergency.

What is the RNLI?

The RNLI is a charity that saves lives at sea. There are 238 RNLI lifeboat stations around the UK coastline.

What is the name of a busy tourist town in North Yorkshire?

Whitby is a busy tourist town on the coast of North Yorkshire, England. It has an old and a new town with the River Esk running through it.

Who was Captain James Cook?

Captain James Cook was a famous explorer who travelled to places that no other European had ever visited.

What problems could boats and ships have at sea?

Boats and ships can sometimes have problems at sea. Rocks, waves and weather can cause boats and ships to capsize.
